

Pecan & Nut Sale FAQs

When will the nuts arrive?

Although it does depend on when the crop is harvested, we are expecting delivery on Monday, November 7.



Do I need to pay for the nuts when I place my order?

Yes, payment is required by October 18 along with your order. Payment by check and cash are accepted (no credit cards). There is information in the Toolkit in the members section of the website (password:p3anz) about peer-to-peer payment systems like Venmo and Paypal to accept credit card payments from your customers.

Will you prorate the donation amount if we don't sell 48 bags?

Families can meet the requirement by selling 48 bags OR by making a \$200 donation in lieu of selling. The amount is not prorated based on how many bags are sold. If you choose the donation in lieu of selling, you can still place an order for nuts - they are delicious and make great gifts!

What do I do if I haven't sold 48 bags by the due date?

Families should place an order for 48 bags and plan to sell the remaining bags once they have arrived.

Will you be ordering extra bags?

YES! Experience tells us that once customers receive their order and sample the nuts they often request more. We will have a limited number of extra bags available on a first come-first served basis. The pralines go fast, and we expect the chocolate ones will too!
